	environmental impacts, reflecting low expectations from the

	as an undue emphasis on road construction itself as opposed to the
	integrated approach used in western parts of the European Union. The
	paper emphasize the need of overall strategic approach to landscape
	and environmental protection, restoration and enhancement in order
	to avoid piecemeal and inappropriate solutions.
